Notes e.g. the following:
The child says out figure out the word, says another word, says a nonsense word, says the word and leaves gaps and says it right, says right but arranges wrongly, says right but arranges wrongly, says right but mixes labels, sorts the labels as requested (first pass C in CAT right), finds labels separately (first pass A in CAT right), sorts influenced by some letters (pre L3C) instead of L3S,3000.
